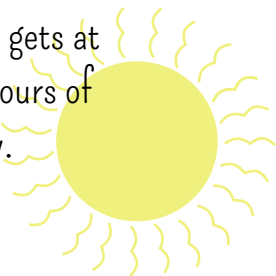


How to Plant a Pollinator Garden

1. Find a garden spot that gets at least 6 hours of sun a day.



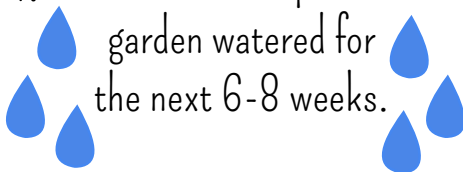
2. Soil Prep: Remove all weeds and take time to loosen clay soil.



3. Plant NATIVE plants or directly plant seeds in the ground after the threat of frost is gone. Make sure all are neonicotinoid* -free.



4. Water. Keep the garden watered for the next 6-8 weeks.



All Pollinator Gardens...

- use NO chemicals; there is no such thing as a safe chemical.
- let all blooming plants bloom; anything that blooms is a food source for something!
- have a saucer of clean water with rocks for bees to drink.

*Neonicotinoid: a chemical used to kill insects
